THE MUSIC LEARNING THEORY OF EDWIN E. GORDON

The Music Learning Theory (MLT) of Edwin E. Gordon (Stamford, 1927- Mason City 2015) is the result of almost fifty years' scientific observations and research by its originator in the USA. It describes the way in which children find out about music from a very early age and is based on the assumption that music can be learnt by processes similar to those whereby language is learned. Parallel to studies on musical aptitude

and the capacity for audiation, which form the theoretical basis of the MLT, a methodology was developed which applies its principles, introducing several major new ideas into the field of musical education. The main aim of Gordon's Music Learning Theory is that of encouraging development of the musical aptitude of each child according to his or her potential, attitude and above all stage in life.



How can we introduce the “digital generation” to musical instruments?







The seagull has gathered his fabulous band for the music party. His friends will come from all over the world bringing with them the voices, colors, and sounds of faraway lands. Who are the musicians in the band? What instrument does each of them play? What surprises has the seagull prepared for his friends? Each 'musician' and his favorite instrument has an illustrated panel with a storyline and a piece of music. The illustrations of twelve musical instruments from every continent stimulate the curiosity of young readers, encouraging them to fantasize, ask questions, and dialogue with the adult who accompanies them in the reading.

Each piece of music highlights the originality of the animal-musician (the character, the rhythmic pattern) and the featured instrument. The variety of musical genres proposed (a waltz for the jellyfish, a tap dance for the penguin, an Irish dance for the monkey, African rhythms for the lion, Asian melodies for the field mice...) introduces children to sounds, modes, and musical forms, both well-known and unfamiliar, thereby enriching their listening vocabulary. This book is also useful as a tool for parents and teachers who want to address the themes of diversity, acceptance, and inclusion through creative and expressive movement experiences.



In a packed theatre an enchanting story is being performed, which tells of how a little girl, who had lost her voice, magically finds it again, helped by some very special friends: the vocal chords, the air and the Big Ear...

An amusing and light-hearted approach to the mechanisms of speech and singing, aided by a text that is a genuine theatre script, in which the characters are itching to escape from the printed page and become real.

The director's notes at the end of the text suggest how to enact the story, leaving plenty of scope for the young actors to give full rein to their imaginations.

Content and method

A tale to explore and explain **the wonders of the human voice** in both its speaking and singing capacities, with reference to the underlying science but with a greater emphasis on the emotional aspects of vocal communication.

The flexible, largely intuitive way in which we develop a relationship with our voice in childhood has a profound influence on how we will use this, our principal tool of communication, throughout our lives.

Drawing attention to the voice in this playful manner, thus cultivating the child's awareness of his or her vocal faculty, promotes the unity of mind and body, essential for a well-balanced development.

The structure of the text as a theatre script encourages the children to become protagonists in the story.
